Accepted materials in your BLUE BIN

(containers, packaging and printed matter)

Paper and cardboard



- Newspapers, flyers, magazines
- Sheets of paper, envelopes and paper bags
- Cardboard rolls
- Cardboard boxes (flat and corrugated, not waxed)
- Packaging (cereal, eggs, etc.)
- Milk, juice and cream cartons
- Aseptic containers (Tetra Pak^{MD} )

Plastic

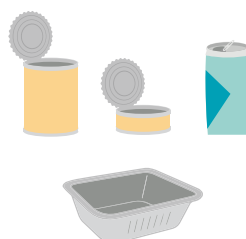


- Bottles, containers and packaging of food products, beverages, cosmetics, personal hygiene products and cleaning products that are marked with any of these symbols:



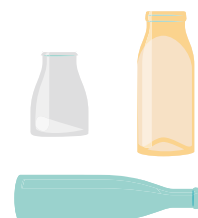
- Caps and lids
- Plastic bags and plastic film (gather bags in a see-through plastic bag)

Metal



- Aluminum containers and foil (plates, dishes, etc.)
- Aluminum cans and bottles
- Tins, caps and lids

Glass




- All glass jars and bottles of any colour and size

Unlike other regions of Québec, **collected glass** in **Vaudreuil-Soulanges** is truly recycled!

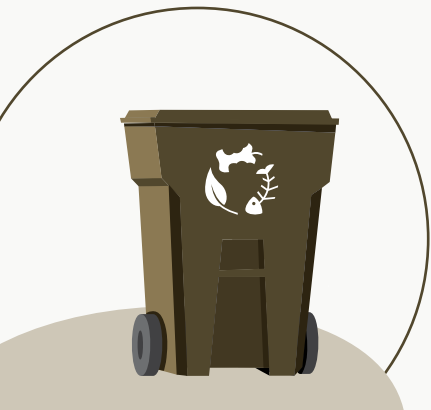


Indeed, our Tricentris sorting center is a pioneer in the recycling and value of glass in North America due to his glass micronization plant in Lachute.

Green waste

Dead leaves, grass and other cut shrubbery, flowers, little branches, indoor plants and potting residues



Other organic matter

- ✓ Small quantities of liquid food that can be absorbed by other residues
- ✓ Fat (vegetable oil, mayonnaise, salad dressing, etc.)
- ✓ Sticks or wooden toothpicks, hair, feathers
- ✓ Sanitary fibres: table napkins, paper towels*, facial tissues
- ✓ Animal feces or litter
- ✓ Cold ashes (cooled at least 72 hours)
- ✓ Paper and cardboard soiled with food: paper plates, pizza boxes, paper and other bags, without metal pins, without plastic, unwaxed
- ✓ Paper bags, with or without compostable cellulose lining

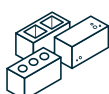

Hazardous household waste

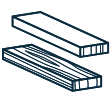
paint and their container : primer, varnish, shellac, aerosol paint mercury / light bulbs : compact fluorescent light bulbs, fluorescent tubes and neon lights, high Intensity Discharge (HID) / Batteries : rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, Li-ion, Ni-Zn, SSLA/Pb) or single use batteries (AAA to D, lithium primary) weighing up to 5 kg
